

TYPES OF VOLCANOES

- 1) **Identify:** Type of Volcano: Shield, Tuff Cone/Cinder Cone, Composite
Type of Lava: MAFIC (thin, low silica, flows easily) or FELSIC (thick, high silica, flows slowly); or BOTH.
Type of Eruption Quiet or Explosive or BOTH
Location: Name of Specific Volcano AND Country
Slope: Base-2° and Summit-10°, Base-5° and Summit-30°, Overall 30-40°
- 2) **Color:** The lava part of each volcano (red, orange or purple) Other _____
The cinder part of each volcano (black, brown, or gray) Other _____
